sequel by some stranger was not only an infringement of her  
rights, but would be damaging to the asset value of the original  
novel. If you should hear anything further about this continua-  
tion being written or published or privately circulated, please  
let me hear as promptly as possible. If legal action must be  
taken, I would not hesitate to take it.
